

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts are invited in the field of pharmacovigilance and drug safety only •Format of abstract: IMRAD- Introduction (Background and objective), Methodology, Result, Conclusions

• Abstract should not exceed 250 words (Font- Title: Arial, Bold, 16; Sub-headings: Arial, Bold, 14; Content: Arial, 12) excluding title of abstract, names of author and complete address.

• Name of the authors, designations, departments, and name of the institution should be mentioned below the title (Name of the presenting author should be underlined, and bold).

• Each participant can submit only one abstract and registration for conference is must for abstract submission.

File name: The file should be named with Presenter's name_online/offline.
All abstracts are to be mailed to abstractsopicon2023@gmail.com

- The abstracts will be screened for relevance with the conference theme.
- The last date to submit the abstract is 25/04/23.

• Communication regarding acceptance and presentation will be sent to the author by mail.

If the abstract is accepted, an e-poster code will be sent through the mail by 30/04/23 – which is to be included in poster.

- Allotted Time for Presentation: 5 min + Q & A: 2 min. Time schedule will be strictly followed.
- E-posters should be prepared in pptx (PowerPoint slide).
- E-poster size / Layout: Landscape Single page.
- E-Poster size in cm: 40.97 inches width × 23.04 inches height.
- Font type and size: Title: Arial (bold), 54
- E-Poster code: Arial, 40 (on the right upper corner)
- Name & affiliation of the presenter: Arial (bold), 44 [presenter name to be underlined].
- Subheadings (e.g., Introduction, methodology, results, conclusion): Arial (bold), 36.
- Content: Arial, 36.
- References (Maximum 02): Arial 32.
- Theme colours of the template can be changed but the contrast should be maintained between the font and background
- SOPICON 2023, AIIMS Rishikesh to be included on the poster (on left upper corner).
- The file should be named with an e-poster code provided by the organizers _ Presenter's name. [example: e-poster code_Pramod]
- The last date for submission of the e- poster: 05/05/23
- All e-poster are to be mailed to abstractsopicon2023@gmail.com
- The participants should be present online 15 min prior to the time slot.
